IPCM RECORDS IDR 196.44 BILLION PROFIT, STRENGTHENS POSITION IN THE PORT SERVICES INDUSTRY

Jakarta, March 17, 2026 – PT Jasa Armada Indonesia Tbk (IDX: IPCM), part of the Pelindo Group, recorded positive financial performance throughout the 2025 fiscal year. Based on the audited financial statements by Purwanto, Susanti and Surja Public Accounting Firm (a member firm of Ernst & Young Global Limited), IPCM posted revenue growth of 9.65% in 2025, reaching IDR 1.47 trillion compared to IDR 1.34 trillion in the previous year.

Along with this revenue growth, the Company successfully recorded a 17.74% increase in net profit to IDR 196.44 billion compared to IDR 166.84 billion in the previous year. This increase demonstrates that the company's strategic plans for expansion and business model strengthening have been implemented as planned and have generated improved operational performance through enhanced pilotage and towage services. In addition, the company's policies to improve operational efficiency and cost management have also proven to contribute positively to the Company.

Throughout 2025, the largest revenue contribution came from towage services amounting to IDR 1.32 trillion, representing 89.51% of total revenue. Pilotage services contributed IDR 105.07 billion or 7.12%, while the remainder came from transportation and other services amounting to IDR 49.67 billion or 3.37%.

From a financial position perspective, IPCM once again demonstrated strong fundamentals by recording a 3.91% increase in total assets to IDR 1.71 trillion and a 5.48% increase in total equity to IDR 1.36 trillion at the end of 2025. This provides a solid foundation for the Company to pursue business expansion and strengthen operational services in the future.

IPCM President Director, Shanti Puruhita, stated that this achievement is the result of the company's consistency in enhancing maritime service quality, improving operational efficiency, and expanding strategic collaboration within the national port sector.

"IPCM's performance growth in 2025 reflects the resilience of the company's business model and our commitment to delivering reliable and competitive maritime services. Going forward, IPCM will continue to strengthen synergies within the Pelindo Group ecosystem and develop new business opportunities to create sustainable added value for shareholders and stakeholders," said Shanti.

As a port services company focusing on pilotage, towage, mooring, and other maritime services, IPCM remains optimistic about the growth prospects of Indonesia's maritime industry, which continues to expand alongside increasing trade and logistics activities across the country.

This was demonstrated by the Company further strengthening its strategic partnerships in 2025 with PT Pelabuhan Bukit Prima (PBP) and PT Nusantara Regas through the continuation of



cooperation agreements for towage services at PT Bukit Asam Tbk's Terminal for Own Interest (TUKS) operated by PBP, as well as pilotage and towage services at the Floating Storage and Regasification Unit (FSRU) Special Terminal (Tersus) of PT Nusantara Regas. This cooperation reflects the continued trust of industry partners in IPCM's maritime service quality in supporting industrial port operations.

IPCM expressed its appreciation to all customers, business partners, and shareholders for their continuous support and trust in developing strategic collaborations with the Company. Such constructive support and feedback encourage IPCM to continuously improve service quality and create sustainable added value.

Amid the challenging dynamics of global geopolitical conditions, IPCM will continue to drive performance improvement through fleet optimization, strengthening services in strategic areas, and developing service innovations to support the smooth flow of national logistics and provide sustainable added value for investors.

Aligned with these various initiatives, combined with IPCM's strong financial performance, operational achievements, and commitment to sustainability, IPCM further reinforces its role as a port services company that is characterized by integrity, competitiveness, and meaningful contributions to Indonesia's maritime industry.
