### **IPCM BORONG PENGHARGAAN BERGENSI PADA AJANG ANNUAL REPORT AWARD (ARA)**

**Jakarta, 8 Desember 2025.** PT Jasa Armada Indonesia Tbk (IDX: IPCM) yang merupakan bagian dari Pelindo Group, berhasil mengukir prestasi gemilang dalam ajang Annual Report Award (ARA) 2024 yang digelar di Bursa Efek Indonesia (BEI), Jakarta. IPCM berhasil meraih tiga penghargaan sekaligus, yaitu Juara 1 BUMN Klaster 1T–5T, Juara Umum Klaster 1T–5T dan Juara Umum Perusahaan Go Public Non keuangan.

Penghargaan ARA 2024 ini diterima langsung oleh Direktur Utama IPCM, Shanti Puruhita didampingi Komisaris Utama, R.R Dewi Ariyani, Komisaris, F. Budi Prayitno, Komisaris Independen, Doni Istyanto Hari Mahdi dan Mitchell Julius Tupamahu beserta Direktur Armada dan Operasi, Arief Hermawan serta Direktur Keuangan, SDM & Manajemen Risiko, Dessy Emastari Prihatiningtyas di Gedung Bursa Efek Indonesia pada Senin (8/12).

Pelaksanaan ARA 2024 kembali hadir di tahun 2025, merupakan ajang tahunan yang menilai kualitas Laporan Tahunan dan Laporan Keberlanjutan perusahaan tahun buku 2024 dan diselenggarakan melalui kolaborasi Komite Nasional Kebijakan Governansi (KNKG) bersama 7 (tujuh) instansi, yakni Otoritas Jasa Keuangan (OJK), Kementerian Koordinator Bidang Perekonomian, Kementerian Dalam Negeri, Badan Pengaturan BUMN, Direktorat Jenderal Pajak Kementerian Keuangan, BEI, serta Ikatan Akuntan Indonesia (IAI).

ARA 2024 kali ini mengusung tema “Leading with Integrity, Transparency, and Accountability: The Path to a Sustainable Future”, menegaskan bahwa Laporan Tahunan tidak lagi dipandang sebatas kewajiban regulasi, melainkan instrumen penting bagi investor dan pemangku kepentingan untuk menilai kualitas governansi dan keberlanjutan bisnis perusahaan. Sejalan dengan tema tahun ini, aspek pengungkapan akan dinilai tidak hanya dari kepatuhan terhadap regulasi, tetapi juga bagaimana integritas diintegrasikan dalam strategi bisnis perusahaan untuk memberikan dampak positif terhadap reputasi dan keberlanjutan jangka panjang.

Tahun ini, sebanyak 206 perusahaan mendaftar sebagai peserta ARA 2024, meningkat 23 persen dibandingkan tahun sebelumnya. Setelah melalui proses seleksi, 171 perusahaan dinilai secara komprehensif melalui desk evaluation dan wawancara langsung dengan pimpinan perusahaan. Penilaian mengacu pada berbagai standar terkini, antara lain POJK 51/2017, SEOJK 16/2021, Pedoman Umum Governansi Korporat Indonesia (PUGKI) 2021, serta ASEAN Corporate Governance Scorecard (ACGS).

Perbedaan pada ARA 2024 ini adalah pengelompokan peserta berdasarkan 3 (tiga) klaster pendapatan (<1 triliun, 1–5 triliun, >5 triliun). Partisipasi pun semakin beragam, terdapat sebanyak 71 perusahaan go public, 100 perusahaan non-go public, 50 perusahaan sektor keuangan, 121 perusahaan sektor non-keuangan, termasuk 105 perusahaan BUMN. Sebagai salah satu peserta, IPCM masuk dalam kategori klaster pendapatan 1-5 triliun, BUMN, dan go public non-keuangan.

Sementara itu, Ketua Dewan Juri ARA 2024 Lindawati Gani menyoroti penilaian tahun ini lebih menekankan pengungkapan transparan, integritas, serta pemikiran terintegrasi (integrated



thinking). Perusahaan dinilai berdasarkan kemampuan menginternalisasi strategi keberlanjutan dalam proses bisnisnya. Dengan memasukkan aspek-aspek di atas, perusahaan dapat menciptakan Laporan Tahunan yang tidak hanya informatif tetapi juga menarik perhatian para penilai (juri) ARA 2024. Pendekatan ini memungkinkan perusahaan untuk menunjukkan keunggulan kompetitifnya, sekaligus memberikan nilai tambah bagi pemangku kepentingan.

"Dalam proses penilaian, Dewan Juri ARA 2024 selalu menjaga objektivitas penjurian. Hal ini tercermin melalui proses penjurian yang dilakukan secara independen dan menjunjung tinggi profesionalisme. Sesuai dengan prinsip governance yang baik. Keseluruhan proses penjurian dilakukan tetap berada di bawah oversight dari pimpinan KNKG," ujar Lindawati.

Penghargaan ini mencerminkan komitmen kuat IPCM dalam menyusun Laporan Tahunan yang memenuhi standar tinggi integritas, transparansi, dan akuntabilitas. Laporan tersebut juga dinilai berdasarkan praktik tata kelola dan keberlanjutan yang solid. Melalui penghargaan ini juga semakin mengukuhkan posisi IPCM sebagai perusahaan jasa maritim nasional yang modern dan kredibel. Di tengah dinamika industri kemaritiman, keberhasilan dalam kompetisi ARA 2024 menunjukkan bahwa IPCM mampu menjalankan operasional yang efisien sekaligus mempertahankan kepatuhan pada standar pelaporan dan tata kelola yang berkelanjutan.

Komisaris Utama PT Jasa Indonesia Tbk, R.R Dewi Ariyani menyampaikan, "Atas nama Dewan Komisaris, saya mengucapkan selamat dan terima kasih kepada Direksi, manajemen, dan seluruh insan JAI. Penghargaan ini adalah milik kita semua, dan menjadi penyemangat untuk terus menghadirkan kinerja terbaik serta menjaga JAI sebagai perusahaan yang modern, berdaya saing, dan dapat dipercaya."

Meraih kesuksesan dalam ajang ARA membutuhkan keberanian melampaui standar dasar dengan menyajikan informasi yang kreatif, relevan, dan inovatif. Pendekatan ini dapat mengubah Laporan Tahunan perusahaan menjadi alat strategis yang mampu memperkuat reputasi serta membangun kepercayaan di kalangan publik dan pemangku kepentingan.

Direktur Utama PT Jasa Armada Indonesia Tbk, Shanti Puruhita, menyampaikan rasa syukur dan apresiasi atas pencapaian ini. "Penghargaan ini merupakan wujud dari kerja keras seluruh insan IPCM yang terus berkomitmen menjaga standar tata kelola terbaik. Kami percaya bahwa laporan tahunan bukan sekadar kewajiban, tetapi bagian penting dari transparansi dan pertanggungjawaban perusahaan kepada pemangku kepentingan. Prestasi ini menjadi motivasi bagi kami untuk terus meningkatkan kualitas pelaporan dan kinerja perusahaan kedepan," ujarnya.

### **IPCM SWEEPS PRESTIGIOUS AWARDS AT THE ANNUAL REPORT AWARD (ARA)**

**Jakarta, December 8, 2025.** PT Jasa Armada Indonesia Tbk (IDX: IPCM), a subsidiary of Pelindo Group, proudly achieved remarkable success at the 2024 Annual Report Award (ARA) held at the Indonesia Stock Exchange (IDX) in Jakarta. IPCM secured three prestigious accolades: First Place in the SOE Cluster 1T–5T, Overall Winner in the 1T–5T Cluster, and Overall Winner in the Non-Financial Public Company category.

The awards were personally received by IPCM President Director, Shanti Puruhita, accompanied by President Commissioner R.R. Dewi Ariyani, Commissioner F. Budi Prayitno, Independent Commissioners Doni Istyanto Hari Mahdi and Mitchell Julius Tupamahu, as well as Director of Fleet and Operations Arief Hermawan and Director of Finance, HR & Risk Management Dessy Emastari Prihatiningtyas, during the ceremony at the IDX Building on Monday (December 8).

ARA 2024, returning this year, is an annual event that evaluates the quality of Annual Reports and Sustainability Reports for the 2024 fiscal year. It is organized through collaboration between the National Committee on Governance Policy (KNKG) and seven institutions: the Financial Services Authority (OJK), the Coordinating Ministry for Economic Affairs, the Ministry of Home Affairs, the State-Owned Enterprises Regulatory Agency, the Directorate General of Taxes of the Ministry of Finance, IDX, and the Indonesian Institute of Accountants (IAI).

With the theme “Leading with Integrity, Transparency, and Accountability: The Path to a Sustainable Future”, ARA 2024 emphasizes that Annual Reports are no longer seen merely as regulatory obligations but as vital instruments for investors and stakeholders to assess governance quality and business sustainability. This year’s evaluation highlighted disclosure not only in terms of regulatory compliance but also in how integrity is embedded into corporate strategy to positively impact reputation and long-term sustainability.

A total of 206 companies registered for ARA 2024, marking a 23 percent increase from the previous year. Following a rigorous selection process, 171 companies were comprehensively assessed through desk evaluations and direct interviews with company leaders. The assessment referred to updated standards including POJK 51/2017, SEOJK 16/2021, the Indonesian Corporate Governance Code (PUGKI) 2021, and the ASEAN Corporate Governance Scorecard (ACGS).

For the first time, participants were grouped into three revenue clusters (<1 trillion, 1–5 trillion, >5 trillion). Participation was diverse, with 71 public companies, 100 non-public companies, 50 financial sector firms, 121 non-financial sector firms, and 105 SOEs. IPCM competed in the 1–5 trillion revenue cluster, as an SOE and non-financial public company.

ARA 2024 Jury Chair Lindawati Gani highlighted that this year’s evaluation placed greater emphasis on transparent disclosure, integrity, and integrated thinking. Companies were assessed on their ability to internalize sustainability strategies into



business processes, producing Annual Reports that are not only informative but also compelling to the jury. This approach enables companies to showcase competitive advantages while delivering added value to stakeholders.

“This year’s judging process was conducted independently and professionally, maintaining objectivity in line with good governance principles, under the oversight of KNKG leadership,” Lindawati stated.

The recognition underscores IPCM’s strong commitment to preparing Annual Reports that uphold the highest standards of integrity, transparency, and accountability, while reflecting solid governance and sustainability practices. This achievement further strengthens IPCM’s position as a modern and credible national maritime services company. Amid the dynamic maritime industry, IPCM’s success at ARA 2024 demonstrates its ability to operate efficiently while maintaining compliance with sustainable governance and reporting standards.

On behalf of the Board of Commissioners, President Commissioner R.R. Dewi Ariyani expressed appreciation: “I extend my congratulations and gratitude to the Board of Directors, management, and all IPCM personnel. This award belongs to all of us and serves as motivation to continue delivering the best performance while maintaining IPCM as a modern, competitive, and trustworthy company.”

President Director Shanti Puruhita also conveyed her gratitude: “This award is the result of the hard work of all IPCM personnel who remain committed to upholding the highest standards of governance.
